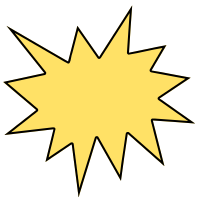
For returning parents: Your passes is valid until the end of year (December 2009).

Gate passes in the new format will be placed on the website in the first week of December 09. We will keep you posted.

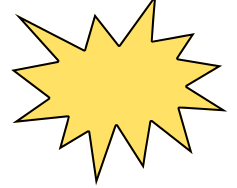
