In accepting this Vehicle Access Pass, I declare that it's use will be in accordance with The Oasis Gardens Security Policy.

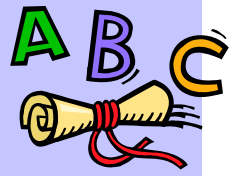
