Dear Parents,

Re Closure of school.

Below, you will see our main objectives during the closure of the school.

During this period, the implementation of individualised student learning will be the responsibility of all teachers and learning assistants. They will be using email / web as the teaching medium – the learning, assessment and feedback will however be more individualized. This will include making contact with ALL students via the website. Please make sure you check the website daily.

- We will continue with the same rigour and high expectations as if students were at school. This must be made clear to all students. They are not on holiday.
- It will be up to students to check the website daily and collect their assignments as per teachers instructions.
- Differentiated work will be provided for all students. This will include SEN (including EAL) if necessary.
- We will expect all students to complete their assignments on time as set by the teacher.
- Teachers will continue with assessments and the marking of work as if students were in school. We will not change the deadlines for student assessments.
- The Code of Conduct still applies for students who do not return assignments. Parents will be contacted where the student does not respond. Such contact will be immediate before work piles up. I am sure that as parents you will all realise the importance of this and teachers will operate a zero tolerance policy. We need your utmost support.
- The parent student teacher triangle has just tipped over a bit – with you as a parent taking a more active role. If students claim they cannot access the internet – please try to make this your priority for the sake of the continuation of your child's education. Please ensure that your son / daughter is aware of the teachers expectations.
- We will still go ahead with parent meetings as planned and indeed more of them – you will be invited in occasionally, so that we can explain to you how you can help us help your child. Keep an eye on the website.

· We cannot see this as a school closure, but as a continuation of education using a different medium. Continuation of your child's education is of paramount concern to us.

· We will endeavor to continue to provide a first class education.
